Community Engagement mini-research Project attempts to provide opportunities for students to deepen their understanding of academic domains and bridge to the community. More importantly, students can take the lead to disseminate their mini-research results to others. Findings, reports, and recommendations will be presented through 2 minutes video or poster presentation.

Support and resources:

The project includes a series of training to enhance students' understanding of selected issues. An individual will have HK \$300 ; Team will have \$500 materials fee for video production and poster presentation.

Who should join the project:

All SCE and CIE students are welcome. We are looking for students who are diverse, enthusiastic, and desire to explore and provide constructive recommendations to understand social issues.

Project content:

The project should include at least 1) a community partner, 2) 2-3 academic journals readings and a personal reflection on the selected issues.

Project Outcome:

Each individual or team will present a 2 minutes video or a 1-page abstract and a full report (within 1,500 words) on a particular issue. The 2 minutes video or poster presentation will be organized for students to present the analysis, conclusions, and recommendations on campus and engage in further discussion with participants.

Duration:

Self - schedule

Certification:

Members will be awarded a Certificate after completing the entire project.
