ARE PHILOSOPHICALLY AT LEAST AS ATTRACTIVE, IF NOT MORE
SO, THAN PRINCIPLES OF CARE AND AUTONOMY THAT HAVE BEEN
DOMINANT IN ENGLISH-SPEAKING DISCOURSES.
