## Campus

The programme is offered at the Hong Kong Baptist University's Shek Mun (Shatin) Campus, which is located next to the Shek Mun Station of MTR Ma On Shan Line. With a gross floor area of 30,000m<sup>2</sup>, the campus provides full university facilities, including indoor swimming pool, gymnasium, auditorium, multimedia laboratories, library and learning commons. Special learning facilities such as bioeco laboratory, food sensory laboratory, testing and analytical laboratory, food & nutritional science laboratory, active living laboratory, social science research laboratory, media communication laboratory, psychology laboratory, press conference room and child assessment centre are also set up to provide students with practical experiences in their areas of study.

## Tuition Fee

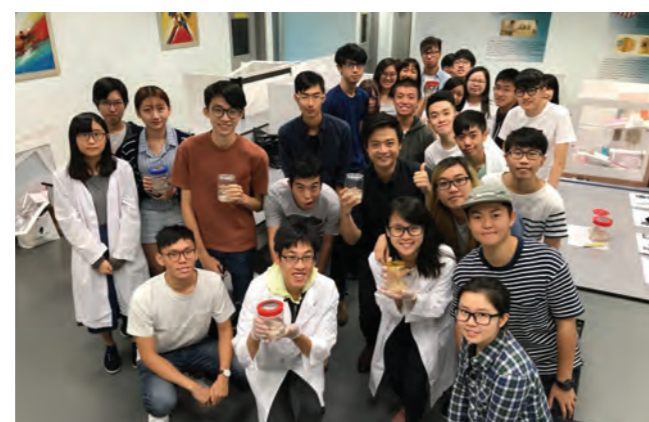
HKD82,500 per year. Students are required to complete 66 units in two years at HKD2,500 per unit (Total HKD165,000).

The annual tuition fee is paid in two equal installments, normally before the start of the first and the second semesters. For newly enrolled undergraduate students, HKD15,000 of the first installment plus some fees will have to be paid by the applicants for acceptance of their admission offers and the balance will have to be paid in late August. Students are required to pay full tuition fees per semester during the normal period of study, regardless of the number of units enrolled in the semester.

For students who are required to take make-up course(s) to fulfill the programme pre-requisites and/or GE courses, additional tuition fee for the make-up course(s) will be charged at HKD1,650 per unit.

## Financial Assistance

Full-time local students may apply for the Financial Assistance Scheme for Post-secondary Students (FASP) and the Non-means-tested Loan Scheme for Post-secondary Students (NLSPS) administered by the Student Finance Office (SFO) under the Working Family and Student Financial Assistance Agency (WFSFAA), HKSAR Government. ## Admission Requirements

To be eligible for admission, a candidate should hold

- an Associate Degree (AD) from any of the local/overseas recognised institutions; or
- a Higher Diploma (HD) from any recognised institutions.

Candidates who possess equivalent qualifications are to be assessed on a case-by-case basis.

Final year Associate Degree / Higher Diploma students may also apply for admission whereas their offer will only be confirmed upon the successful completion of the Associate Degree / Higher Diploma programme.

Applicants will be required to attend an admission interview as part of the selection process.

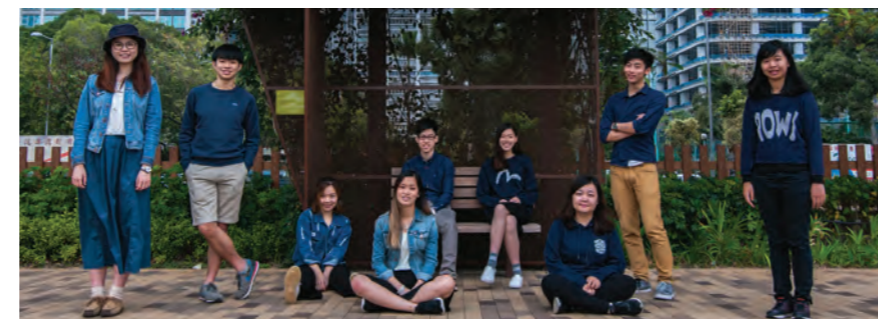
Students are expected to complete all programme pre-requisites and GE courses in their Associate Degree / Higher Diploma studies. Otherwise, they may have to complete additional units of study to make up for the programme pre-requisites and GE courses at College of International Education (CIE), Hong Kong Baptist University.

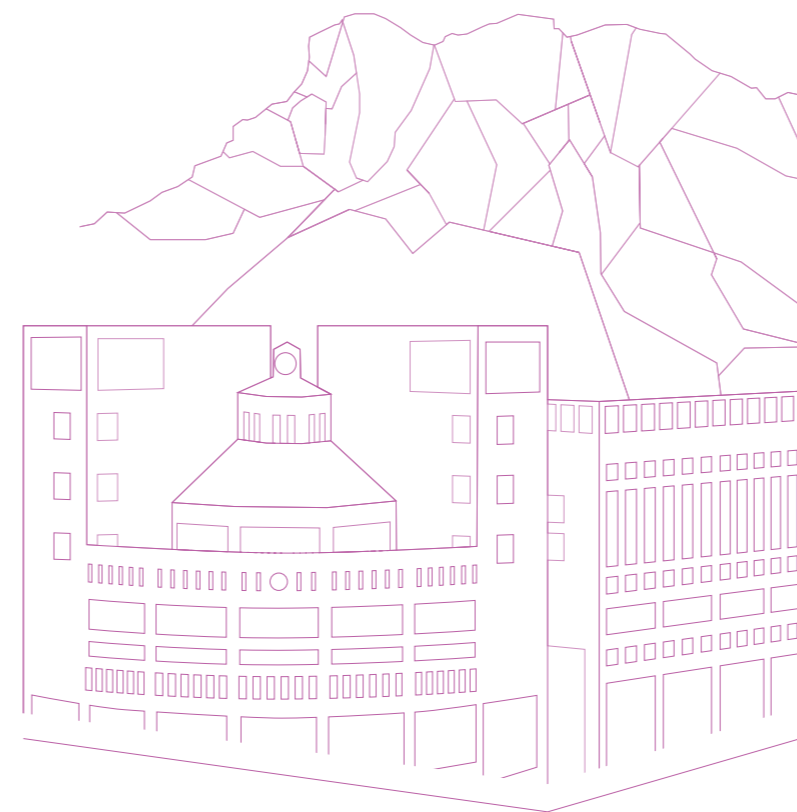

# Bachelor of Social Sciences (Honours) in Psychology

## 心理學社會科學學士 (榮譽) 學位課程

Offered by Faculty of Social Sciences at the Shek Mun Campus of Hong Kong Baptist University, the Bachelor of Social Sciences (Honours) in Psychology is specially designed for holders of Associate Degree (AD) or Higher Diploma (HD) who wish to pursue psychology as their field of studies.

- Providing students with a solid training in the theoretical, empirical and applied aspects of psychology.

## Career Prospects

Our programme is designed to prepare students for careers in psychology and related fields, such as social services, education, research, health care, communication, and different careers in helping professional and commercial settings. Graduates are eligible to apply for postgraduate programmes in the above areas, as well as membership with the Hong Kong Psychological Society (HKPS), the British Psychological Society (BPS) and the Australian Psychological Society (APS) (membership applications are assessed on individual basis for these societies).

## PROGRAMME STRUCTURE

This undergraduate programme is basically a four-year full-time honours undergraduate programme catering for Associate Degree / Higher Diploma graduates concentrated in Psychology. Students with an Associate of Science / Higher Diploma in Psychology or equivalent may apply for direct admission to Year Three of the programme and to complete a total of 66 units for graduation.

Associate Degree / Higher Diploma graduates of other disciplines are required to complete certain pre-requisites, including General Education and Free Elective Courses required by Hong Kong Baptist University. The exact courses to be exempted and the number of pre-requisites to be completed shall be considered on a case-by-case basis upon admission.

Specifically, students are required to complete 48 units of Major Core Courses and 18 units of Major Elective Courses.

## YEAR 1 & YEAR 2

### GENERAL EDUCATION (38 UNITS)

The General Education (GE) Programme provides the foundation of a well-rounded university education by promoting **Whole Person Education**. The 38 units required under the GE requirements are divided into two categories - Core Requirements and Distribution Requirements.

### DISTRIBUTION REQUIREMENTS# (12 UNITS)

\* For Associate Degree & Higher Diploma applicants, block exemption for University English, University Chinese, Information Management Technology, and Numeracy will be granted.

# For Associate Degree applicants, there will be block exemption for all Distribution Requirements. For Higher Diploma applicants, block exemption for any 1 course of Distribution Requirements will be granted.

### PROGRAMME PRE-REQUISITE / FREE ELECTIVE COURSES (24 UNITS)

Students should have taken courses in statistics and general psychology as pre-requisites in their Associate Degree / Higher Diploma studies. Free Elective Courses are normally exempted for Associate Degree / Higher Diploma graduates seeking for year 3 entry.

Remarks:

1. The number of courses/units the students are required to complete will depend on the number of courses/units for which exemption and/or unit transfer will be granted. All unit transfer or course exemption shall be considered on a case-by-case basis upon admission. Students are required to complete all programme pre-requisites and GE courses to meet the graduation requirements.
2. Exempted courses equivalent to 38 units of GE courses will be considered by the Programme on a case-by-case basis.
3. Make-up courses may be required on admission.
